



# ADDITIONAL NOTES

Once you start reading the Bible looking for the Trinity you find it everywhere. I have just read Titus, a short letter of only 3 chapters.

Three times it says "God our Saviour", and three times "Jesus our Saviour". For instance, verses 3 and 4 of chapter one read:

*at his appointed season he brought his word to light through the preaching entrusted to me by the command of **God our Saviour**,  
To Titus, my true son in our common faith:  
Grace and peace from God the Father and **Christ Jesus our Saviour**. (my emphasis)*

In 2:14 Paul unites the two: *the glorious appearing of our great God and Saviour, Jesus Christ.*

And then in 3:4-6 we read:

*But when the kindness and love of God our Saviour appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Saviour.*

So we see the Father, we see Jesus, and they are linked in their activity by the Holy Spirit too.
